## CMLC to unveil new office, hold first juried art show

Join CMLC staff and trustees from 5-8 p.m. tomorrow as they celebrate their new building with their first ever juried art show. Set to exhibit from July 18-Oct. 17, the show will be the first in a series of four that will be held throughout the year. All exhibits will center on nature themes, feature local artists, and be juried by local galleries. The first juror will be Patricia Cole-Ferullo, represented by Silver Fox Gallery, in downtown Hendersonville.

In October of 2008 Carolina Mountain Land Conservancy trustees broke ground on a new 3,200 sq ft custom built, passive solar, and energy efficient office building in southeast Hendersonville. Located at 847 Case St. in the nonprofit campus, Ironwood Square, the completion of this building project brings to a close nearly a decade of paying facility rent. CMLC is excited to unveil their new building to members, media, and the community. "It is our mission not only to conserve land but to protect it in perpetuity. Having a permanent home is a huge step for our organization as well as the community. This new building is a tribute to the many members, donors, and volunteers upon whom CMLC's success firmly rests," says Kieran Roe Executive Director.
